ACP FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

ACP's Faculty Development Program provides instruction on the most effective teaching techniques for educators to plan and execute a variety of methods to engage learners and improve their success regardless of their education setting.

This 2-day course is offered in Spanish.

Audience: For program leaders, medical educators, and clinical teachers (all experience levels).

Format: Engaging and brief 30 minute lectures on each topic, followed by small group workshops, led by local facilitators. Exercises allow attendees to work on principles taught and with unique educational formats designed to meet particular needs.

Materials: Attendees will receive pre- and post- course materials which include excerpts from ACP's *Teaching Medicine series*. Certificates of Attendance are provided upon course completion.

Gustavo Heudebert, MD, MACP – lead faculty University of Alabama. School of Medicine

Dr. Heudebert is a native Peruvian. He graduated from the Universidad Peruana Cayetano Heredia and came to the US where he completed residency training at Henry Ford Hospital in Detroit, MI. He has worked at the University of Alabama-Birmingham (UAB) since 1995. His main activities for the last 24 years at UAB include a number of leadership positions in medical education, such as Program Director of Internal Medicine residency training. From 2007 to 2017 he was Chair of the Graduate Education Committee of the University of Alabama Hospital and served as the Associate Dean for Graduate Medical Education in that capacity, as well as that of the Designated Institutional Official (DIO) from 2013 to 2017. Since January 2018 he has served as Interim Dean of the Montgomery Regional Medical Campus. His academic research focuses on the application of quantitative sciences, such as cost effectiveness analyses to clinical problems. He has also embarked on research projects in medical education with an emphasis on graduate medical education. In particular, Dr. Heudebert is interested in applying analytical tools utilized in health services research to advance knowledge in medical education.

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Maria (Gaby) Frank, MD, FACP University of Colorado, School of Medicine

Dr. Frank is a medical educator and an Internal Medicine trained hospitalist at a large level-one trauma center, university-affiliated hospital in Denver, Colorado. She completed medical school at the University of Buenos Aires, Argentina in 1998 and completed both an Internal Medicine and Emergency Medicine residencies in Buenos Aires, before moving to the US in 2004, where she completed another IM residency at the University of Colorado School of Medicine. Dr. Frank has completed certificates in curriculum development and leadership in educational administration at the University of Colorado. She participated in the curricular reform for the University of Colorado, SOM and is actively involved in faculty development programs. Currently, Dr. Frank is a hospitalist, Medical Director for the Biocontainment Unit and Associate Director for the Department of Medicine at Denver Health Hospital Authority. She is also Director of Faculty Development and Advancement for the Division of Hospital Medicine, the Human Body Block Clinical Director and an Associate Professor of Medicine for the University of Colorado, School of Medicine, the Human Body Block Clinical Director and an Associate Professor of Medicine for the University of Colorado, School of Medicine.

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Carlos Estrada, MD, FACP University of Alabama, School of Medicine

Dr. Estrada received his medical degree from Cayetano Heredia University in Lima, Peru. He completed his internship, residency, Chief Medical Residency, and fellowship at Henry Ford Hospital in Detroit, Michigan. Dr. Estrada also earned a Master of Science in Clinical Research Design and Statistical Analysis at the University of Michigan School of Public Health in Ann Arbor, Michigan. Dr. Estrada has spent 25 years in large academic medical centers and has led many successful multi-disciplinary collaborations in all three mission areas: patient care, research, and education. His current focus is faculty leadership, clinical training, and quality improvement. Currently, Dr. Estrada is Professor of Medicine and Director of the Division of General Internal Medicine at the University of Alabama at Birmingham. He is also Chief of the Section of General Internal Medicine at the Birmingham Veterans Affairs Medical Center and co-directs the VA Quality Scholar (VAQS) Fellowship Program, a two-year interprofessional post-graduate education program with the main goal of developing leaders and scholars to improve healthcare. In 2017, he was named Associate Provost for Interprofessional Education and Director, Center for Interprofessional Education & Simulation at the University of Alabama at Birmingham.
